Mawklot Primary Milk Producers Co-operative Society

The Mawklot Primary Milk Producers Co-operative Society was started in 1995, with the intention to better the lives of dairy farmers in the village. It started on a small scale, with few members. It acts as a procurement and marketing agency for the dairy farmers of Mawklot, the co-operative's area of operation. The co-operative purchases the milk from members and sells to the Veterinary Department; for this the co-operative charges a small commission. The farmer does not have to look for ways to market the milk produced at his farm, he only has to bring it to the cooperative and the secretary ensures sale of the milk brought in by its members. The co-operative sells the milk to the Government Chilling Plant through the Veterinary Department. The vehicle from the Veterinary Department comes to the village every morning to collect milk from the members at different collection points. This helps farmers save on transport and time.

The co-operative also gives advances and loans to its members for purchase of feed, medicines, and cattle. As members of the co-operative, individual dairy farmers can also avail various schemes and grants from government departments to expand their business. With approximately 1700 Litres of milk supplied per day to the Veterinary Department, the co-operative is one of the leading milk producers in Shillong.
